Rule – Dress standards for industry participants

On 6 March 2018 the Combat Sports Authority (the Authority) made the following resolution in relation to the rule made under section 107 of the *Combat Sports Act 2013* entitled ***Rule – Dress standards for industry participants***.

The Combat Sports Authority grants approval to each person that holds professional referee, judge and/or timekeeper registration classes under the Combat Sports Act 2013 to wear at a combat sport contest a shirt issued by the Australian National Boxing Federation Ltd or the N.S.W. A.N.B. F. Incorporated with:

- a. *“Carman & Associates Australian Immigration Law Specialists 02 9112 3999” printed in black lettering on a white background on the rear of the shirt, and*
- b. *the Australian National Boxing Federation emblem on the front on the shirt.*
